What is considered "hazardous?"

Any product that is out of date or not being used has the potential to be labeled "hazardous." These items can be found in your basement, garage, under the kitchen sink, craft area, workshop, etc. Look for words on the label such as:



Toxic

***Caution, Warning, Danger,
Poison, Flammable, Combustible, or Corrosive***

How do I properly dispose of these hazardous materials?

- Please keep individual materials in their original, separate containers.
- **DO NOT MIX!**
- Containers must be 5 gallons in size or less.
- Place your materials in a sturdy cardboard box lined with plastic.
- Separate each product with a folded newspaper.
- If a container is leaking, put it in a secondary leak-proof container.
- Pack containers in your trunk away from the driver, passengers, or pets.

Why Should I participate in a Clean Sweep Program?

Hazardous household wastes, yard care materials, and electronic wastes are only a small percentage of the waste stream. However, they are still considered a serious problem. When disposed of improperly, hazardous wastes can threaten our drinking water, damage our lakes and rivers, and threaten the health of sanitation workers. If these wastes are left around the house, garage, or farmstead they pose a threat of accidental poisoning to children and animals.

- **Waste motor oil**
- **Propane cylinders**
- **Explosives**
(ammunition & fireworks)
- **Infectious & biological wastes**
- **Radioactive materials**
(smoke alarms)
- **Latex paint**

- Household clean sweep items and yard care materials can be taken to the site at the time listed.
